

Showcase your research and represent the University of Tennessee at a regional, state, or national conference. We are pleased to announce the addition of an **Undergraduate Research Travel Grants** program to our program offerings.

Students presenting their work at conferences may apply for funds to partially defray the costs of registration and travel. The amounts awarded are:

- \$300 for regional conferences (TN and any contiguous state)
- \$500 for national conferences
- \$800 for international conferences
